

Ad for Assistant Professor in Computer Science

The Department of Computer Science at the University of West Florida (UWF), Pensacola, Florida, invites applications for an Assistant Professor position in Computer Science (Position #121130). Applicants with experience in Cyber Security related areas will be preferred.

Minimum qualifications: Doctoral degree from an accredited institution or the highest degree appropriate in the field of specialization with a demonstrated record of achievement in teaching, academic research, and service.

Preferred qualifications: Ph.D. in Computer Science or closely related discipline from an accredited institution. Applicants are expected to have a strong commitment to teaching in both face-to-face and online learning environments at both the graduate and undergraduate levels, mentor students in a Cyber Security area, and develop strong research agendas in Cyber Security or related areas. The Assistant Professor position will have a standard workload that balances teaching, research and service. A successful candidate will be expected to teach 3 courses a semester and conduct research and service activities.

Nationally recognized Cyber Security Certifications will be preferable such as those listed by NICCS <http://niccs.us-cert.gov/training/professional-certifications> or DoD 8570 Baseline Certifications <http://iase.disa.mil/eta/iawip/contentpages/iabaseline.html>.

Salary is commensurate with education and experience. Appointment will begin in August, 2016.

The Department of Computer Science at the University of West Florida has state-of-the-art computer lab and classroom facilities and is seeking applicants who can develop and enhance its newly launched Cyber Security program at both the bachelor's as well as the master's level. Successful applicants will find this to be a stimulating environment conducive to professional growth and interdisciplinary collaborative research. Applicants are encouraged to submit their applications by October 30, 2015, but the position will remain open until filled.
